Ride 365

Daylight hours are getting shorter but there's still plenty of time remaining this year to rack up miles in HOG's *Ride 365* Annual and Chapter mileage challenges. As the year comes to an end, make sure you get your final milage reading so you can get credit for the



miles you've ridden this year. HOG has decided that HOG members logging miles for HOG *Ride 365* can continue using the QR code odometer reading process introduced during the 2025 *Let's Ride Challenge*. This process will remain in place for 2026, allowing members and dealers to validate mileage using the same convenient method. It's simple to do:

- ⇒ Scan the in-store QR code.
- ⇒ Enter member number, VIN, and odometer mileage.
- ⇒ Get validated by a dealership employee by scanning the QR code they provide.
- ⇒ Once registered, miles count toward the HOG Ride 365 balance.
- ⇒ HOG has also announced that they will be doing another *Let's Ride Challenge* for 2026. It will start on Saturday, February 28, 2026. So get ready to do this all over again.



Road Captain

Ride Cancellation Considerations

Hello Biggs HOG Members. Wow, the year is almost over and 2026 is fast approaching. This will be my last article as your Road Captain as I will be relieved by Dave H in January. It has been my distinct pleasure to serve as your Road Captain over the last 2 years and I want to thank all of the Road Guards for their continued support.



That being said, we are now in the rainy season here in San Diego County, so I wanted to go over what is taken into consideration when a ride is cancelled.

While we have several "Rain or Shine" events each year, the Road Captain is responsible is to monitor the weather forecast. Not only do I look at the weather at the time and location of the Ride Briefs, but also along the routes, at the destinations, and the ride home from the destination. Many of our riders do not have experience riding in the rain or excessive heat, so I evaluate all of the forecasted weather reports and make the call to cancel rides if there is a threat of inclement weather or excessive heat.



We all have joked about "Monsoonal Moisture" but getting caught in the rain, especially if you are not experienced with riding in the rain, is No Joke. Safety is Priority One and when the Road Captain cancels a ride, it's with the Safety of the whole group in mind. Yes, it sucks having a ride cancelled, but look at it this way: while it's disappointing, we will all be around to ride another day. That's what's important.

Yes, there have been times when rides have been cancelled and the weather forecast did not produce the rain/heat as expected. All we can do is make the best decisions, based on the available information, to ensure the Safety of all riders on our rides.

One last note: We are in short supply of Road Guards. We need Chapter members to step up and help out. We all rely on the Road Guards to manage each ride and make them as safe as possible. Are Road Guards required to have a Chapter ride? No, not by the letter of the law according to HOG, but the Biggs HOG Chapter makes every effort to ensure there are Road Guards on each Chapter ride. Please help us keep the rides as safe as possible. Contact the Road Captain or any Road Guard if you are willing to become a Road Guard. WE NEED YOUR HELP!






