- 4. Picture of Odometer (if you don't know how to send the picture we can help). Just don't fib on mileage.

If you have multiple Harley's (good for you), you will have to turn in mileage for each motorcycle. That is your penalty for being a show off.

Why can't my beginning and ending mileage be the same? Because lesser HOG groups require that you do this through the service department and you normally would have to ride into the dealership to do a reading.

What about Associate Members?

Associate Members are not eligible for the tires or plaque or prizes from our chapter.


