- I don't pretend to know it all. So, my answer may be I don't know.


Ride 365 – HD Sponsored Program

Ride 365 Mileage FAQ

- 1. How do I turn in my mileage
 - a. Ride to Dealership (Preferable HDI but any dealership can register your miles)
 - a. HOG Number
 - b. VIN Number
 - c. Mileage
 - b. If you have multiple Harley's (good for you), you will have to turn in for each motorcycle. That is your penalty for being a show off.
- 2. Why can't my beginning and ending mileage be the same
 - a. You had an ending in 2023 and have to ride to the dealership to turn in for 2024
- 3. What about Associate Members
 - a. Associate Members mileage also needs to be turned in. So you need their HOG # as well.

How do I get there to check?



- There are several options but if you haven't done it simply Google Harley Davidson Ride 365 logon or go to members. Harley-Davidson.com and the scroll down to Ride365.
- Another great tip, enter your first mileage, ride 50 miles and then have them enter it again.

Chapter Mileage Program

- It is for our chapter ONLY

 - Entry for every 1,000 for drawing at the end of the year for a new tire.
