



Road Captain Briefing

1. Introduce the lead and sweeps.
2. Ask if there are any visitors and/or guests.
 - a. Complete waivers if guests are present.
3. Make sure everyone is checked in on HOGSCAN by an officer.
 - i. If no officer is present, submit a list of riders' names to head road captain.
4. Channel 4 on CB
5. Discuss route and comfort stops.
6. Discuss speed limits.
7. Discuss alcohol and drug policy.
8. Staggered formation
 - a. 2 second gap for the bike in directly in front of you
 - b. 1 second gap behind the bike in the diagonal position
 - c. Trikes are positioned in the middle of the lane with a two second gap.
 - d. Bike behind a trike takes the left position, unless it's another trike.
9. All bikes side by side when stopped at light. Keep the group tight. Trikes to stay in the middle of the lane when stopped.
10. No gaps or rubber banding
11. Hand signals – demonstrate – discuss importance.
12. Pass hand signals back – discuss importance.
13. Lane changing procedures – All bikes stay in the same lane as the lead. Do not change lanes until the bike in front of you changes lanes.
14. Discuss the regrouping process if the group gets split up.
15. Discuss incident procedures.
