Sgt. Mad Dog Watts Veterans Foundation

This is the name of the charity formed this year and a brief history of how it all came together. Our thanks to so many who contributed their time, their money, and their insight in what the Foundation stands for.

First, and foremost, our special thanks to the late Steve Watts for seeing a need of many of the Veterans residing at the Veterans Home in The Dallas, Oregon. Over the years prior to Steve passing, he encouraged his fellow Sunset Chapter to contribute small personal items that many of Veterans did not have the extra resources to buy themselves.

To all of the supporting Chapter members who contribute the funds to make those purchases, which in 2020 raised \$1200 and in 2021 raised \$1800. A month after Steve passed in 2021 Steve's Estate administrators Russ & Lisa H. matched that \$1800 providing us with almost \$4000 of personal items for those Veterans.

A month later we received a call from Terry & Dorothy M. complementing the Sunset Chapter for their act of kindness and generosity extended to the Veterans in The Dallas. They asked if they donated a 2022 Harley Davidson for us to raffle off, could we assure them all of the funds raised would to go to Veteran organizations. Of course, we happily agreed to that. In organizing the Fundraiser, we discovered we need to be a registered 501c3 Charity or function under an existing registered 501c3. We met with Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association who agreed to let us hold our Raffle event under their existing charity.

A plan was set in place, a ticket value of \$100 per ticket was determined with a limit of only 400 tickets to be sold. Paradise Harley Davidson agreed to help sell the tickets at their customer service counter. With their terrific support and that of the Sunset Chapter members, 4 months later we had sold all of the tickets.

We raised \$40,000, held the drawing on Aug 27, 2022; giving away \$1000 in additional gift cards and awarded the 2022 Harley Davidson motorcycle to Tammy Kromhout as the Grand Prize winner. Tammy has traded the winning bike in for a new 2022 H D Trike. She is excited and looking forward to learning and experiencing the joy of "The Ride" and wants to know how she can help us next year.

Our own Sgt Mad Dog Watts Veterans Foundation has now been approved by the State, and the IRS, and is now able to function as their own Charitable Foundation. We are now in the process of creating our website, having printing material developed and proud to say our wonderful donors have already committed to providing us with another new Harley Davidson for next year's fundraiser. We are also discussing other alternative fundraising activities.

Also, our website when developed will provide some history and information of our charity, updates on our activities, accept contributions to the Foundation, display some of the Veteran organizations we are sponsoring, and when the Motorcycle raffle begins will allow you to purchase tickets through our website.

On behalf of our officers, President Ron Gibson, Treasurer Dan Boss, Secretary Valerie McCarty, and Board members Mike Cuciti and Phil Sheleny. We're all look forward to a productive successful year.

Thanks to all of you for your support.

The 2022 ride season has officially come to an end. Again, we owe our amazing Road Captains a big THANK YOU as they scramble to get us out, and on the roads, when ride season started in April with 24 days of rain. We're looking forward to 2023!!
