## **Secretary's 30 Seconds Sherri Willison**




Greetings Fellow IEHOG Members.



## HOG Chapter Handbook - Group Riding

“Few activities build camaraderie and memories faster than chapter rides.” Hog has put together a series of good practices when it comes to planning, leading, and participating in a ride. A few highlights are below. For the entire list of good practices, read your Chapter Handbook. It can be found on the IEHOG website once you log in.

**Planning a Ride:** “It’s always a good idea to prepare a map of the route with all the stops indicated.” It’s also important that all riders have a map of the route so they can reach the destination on their own if need be. If someone becomes separated from the group, they can catch up at the next stop knowing which route the group is taking.

**Leading the Ride:** “Choose and maintain a comfortable pace within the speed limit.” Remember we are not an exception to the law and the rules of the road should be followed. Try and prevent gaps, but don’t go too slow.

**Participating in a Ride:** “A group of motorcycles is not considered a single vehicle.” As safe riders, we must use common sense and be courteous to other drivers. Everyone should also familiarize yourself with the route and scheduled stops. Last but not least, “Drinking and driving never mix.”


**Keep the Group Together:** “If a rider fall behind, everyone should slow down a little to stay with the tailender.” Again, make sure everyone knows the route so if someone does get separated, they will keep themselves from getting lost.

“Try to **keep the pack tight** without crowding each other. Stay close through intersections and traffic lights so that the group doesn’t become separated. Remember that some riders in the group may not know where they are going and could end up “leading” the remainder of the pack with no idea how to reach their destination.” Ride safe!



Last quarter no one took the challenge to find out who Effie and Avis Hotchkiss were, so here is their story.

## *Effie and Avis Hotchkiss*



Motoring across the United States a century ago was no easy task, especially without paved roads, signage and service stations, among other hardships.

However, on May 2, 1915, 26 year old Effie Hotchkiss began her trek from her hometown in Brooklyn, NY for San Francisco, riding her 3-speed Harley Davidson. Her companion was her 52 year old mother, Avis, sitting in the sidecar.

Effie told one reporter when she reached her destination that she hoped it would demonstrate that “motorcycling is perfectly good as a girl’s sport.” Amazingly, women have always been a part of the Harley-Davidson family and will continue to ride just like their male counterparts.





# 2021 Highlights

While COVID is still fresh on everyone's mind, let's look at what our group has done over the last twelve months under the direction of our 2021 Director, Tom Willison and his leadership team of Jeff Staub, Jodi Rizzotto, Monika Staub, Jennifer Carter, Dennis Palmer, Sherri Willison, Al Navarro, and Geoff Thorn.

Since January 2, 2021, IEHOG members participated in 50 chapter rides totally more than 12,500 miles. That's not only amazing, but the members have ridden 174,000 combined miles.

IEHOG travelled as far south as San Diego, as far north as Carson City, as far east as Tombstone, AZ, as low as 282 feet below sea level (Death Valley) and as high as 8,138 feet above sea level traveling over Conway Summit north of Bishop.

We also had a group of IEHOG members that traveled to Sturgis, South Dakota in 2021 to meet other H-D enthusiasts and enjoy the week-long festivities.

The Ladies of Harley hosted numerous activities such as the Progressive Ride, the Halloween and Christmas Party, Paint & Sip, Beach Ride, monthly get together with other LOH, an ice cream social, and of course the corn hole tournament and pool party. LOH have a fun filled list of activities for 2022.

IEHOG members also participated in a variety of chapter contests including two in The Handlebar Star, the Annual Mileage Contest and the Chapter's Scavenger Hunt.

Winners in the Annual Mileage Contest and Scavenger Hunt will be announced at our January meeting.

Next year will bring us another packed calendar of rides and contests for all members to participate in and potentially win. Will your name end up on the coveted trophy?





## Randsburg, California

A Ghost Town in the Mojave Desert

There are many ghost towns and old mining towns in the Mojave Desert...but, Randsburg is my favorite! My mom lived in the adjacent town of Johannesburg from 1945 to 1950. She lived in a 3-room house that was built by a couple of guys who worked at China Lake NAS. As the story goes, the lumber used to build this home was stolen from the base. My grandfather bought the property for \$750. Mom lived there with her parents and a sister. Mom moved to San Diego with her father in 1950.



My grandparents lived in that house until 1969 when they moved a new mobile home onto the lot next door. It had all the plumbing in it. My grandfather still used the outhouse outside...old school guy! I spent my younger years riding dirt bikes with my dad in the area. I formed a love for the desert that I still have today!



A Rand Mining District California Historical Landmark #938 plaque which was designated on October 12, 1958 reads, "No. 938 Rand Mining District: The Yellow Aster or Rand Mine was discovered in April 1895 by Singleton, Burcham and Mooers. The town of Randsburg quickly developed followed by the supply town of Johannesburg in 1896. Both names were adopted from the profusion of minerals resembling those of the ranch mining district of South Africa. In 1907, Churchill discovered tungsten in Atolia which was used in steel alloy during World War I. In June 1919, Williams and Nosser discovered the famous California Rand Silver Mine at Red Mountain".


As I turn over the Secretary reins to Sherri, I want to thank all of you for friendship and adventures Frank and I have shared with the HOGs over the years.


