DAY 2: Scenic Loop

Our day 2 route is a scenic loop through the Selkirk Mountains and Kootenai River Valley that covers roughly 150-180 miles, taking 3-4 hours of riding time. The route features river canyons, deep forests, mountain passes (via Yaak), and lake views, connecting US-2, US-95, and MT-56.

Route Breakdown

- **Sandpoint to Bonners Ferry (US-95 N):** Start north on US-95, driving through the expansive, forested valley along the Kootenai River.
- **Bonners Ferry to Yaak (US-2 E to Yaak River Rd):** Head east on US-2 through Moyie Springs. Take the scenic detour into the Yaak Valley, a remote, densely forested area known for its rugged, untamed landscape.
- **Yaak to Libby (Yaak River Rd to MT-37 S):** Drive south from Yaak, often following the Yaak River. Merge onto MT-37, which offers scenic views of Lake Koocanusa, a 30,000-acre lake formed by the Libby Dam.
- **Libby to Noxon (MT-56 S):** Take MT-56 south, also known as the Bull Lake Road. This is a quiet, stunningly beautiful stretch passing between the Cabinet Mountains and the Yaak Mountain Range.
- **Noxon to Clark Fork (MT-56 S to MT-200 W):** Merge onto MT-200 heading west to Clark Fork, Idaho. This section hugs the Cabinet Gorge Reservoir and the Clark Fork River.
- **Clark Fork to Sandpoint (ID-200 W):** Take ID-200 West along the shore of Lake Pend Oreille back to Sandpoint. This section is known as the Pend Oreille National Scenic Byway.
