Hello Everyone!



I'm happy to report we have reached 40 members who have enrolled in Harley-Davidson's Ride 365 Program.

This is a significant milestone as it represents almost 44% of our total chapter membership! Congratulations!

If you have not yet enrolled, it is quite easy! Just stop into Volcano Harley-Davidson and speak with Garrett, Khloe or Kadence.

They will get you enrolled in a jiffy! All you need to provide is a picture of your motorcycle odometer statement, vin# and your HOG ID number.

They will do the rest and it should only take about 3-5 minutes.

After that, the only thing left to do is ride and have fun, intermittently stopping into VHD to record your mileage. As your miles accumulate, so do your points and rewards. H.O.G. members now earn one point on their Harley-Davidson VISA® card® for every mile you ride on your H-D® motorcycle, up to 50,000 miles in a calendar year. That's up to 500 in 600 in 600

Remember, if you update your mileage prior to the chapter meeting, you will be entered into a drawing for a \$20 gift card!

**OVERVIEW:** Each new riding season brings excitement back to the road. Track your annual miles with authorized Harley-Davidson dealers to earn badges, certificates, patches, coins, and H-D Membership points after reaching the mileage milestones set forth in the table below.

**PROGRAM PERIOD:** The Annual Mileage Recognition Program (the "Program") begins on January 1, 2024 and ends at 11:59 p.m. U.S. Central Time ("CT") on December 31, 2024.

ELIGIBILITY: The Program is open to all H.O.G.® members (including Lifetime, Full Time members and Associate/Passenger members) who: (i) are legal U.S. residents; (ii) are 18 years of age or older and have reached the age of majority in their respective U.S. state of residence; (iii) have linked their H.O.G. ID to their H-D Membership account in the H-D app or online at HD.com/membership to enable earning points; and (iv) have received at least one mileage reading at a participating H-D dealership.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: To participate in the Program, H.O.G. members will need to have the odometer of their motorcycles recorded at least two times a year at a participating H-D dealerships to determine their respective annual mileage − once on or after January 1, 2024 for an initial reading for the Program, and once on or before December 31, 2024 for the second reading. H.O.G. members will be automatically signed up to participate in the Program after the first mileage recording is taken. (Please note that other H-D™ Ride 365 activities, such as Ride 365 Destination Challenges, require H.O.G. members to enroll online at h-d.com/ride365.) 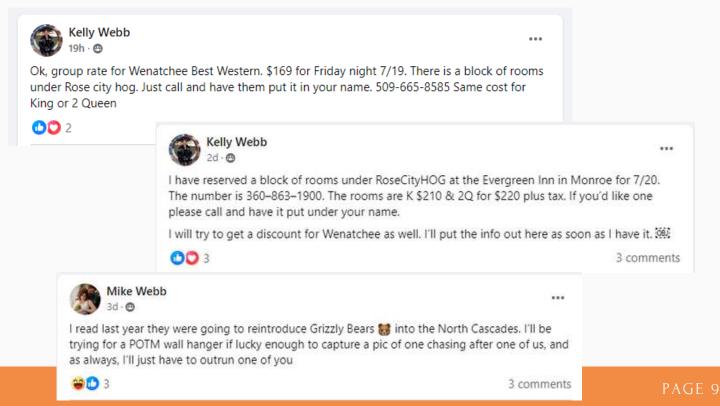


### North Cascades National Park Overnighter

## TECH TIP - NOW IS THE TIME TO GET IN SHAPE TO RIDE!

I should preface this by saying, believe it or not, I am not a fitness expert, nor a doctor. Matter of fact, there is not much you should listen to me about at all.

One thing I learned on a long-distance ride last year is that I am old, and out of shape - unless you consider Pear a shape. It actually takes a lot of muscle strength to ride a motorcycle safely, and it takes conditioning to be able to do it for long distances. With Spring around the corner and clocks being turned ahead this weekend, I think it obvious we are late to the game to get into our best beach bods; however, we are just in time to get a physical tune-up and make sure we are operating at the best of our ability. Following are some tips I found by a simple Google search.

#### **Pull-Ups**

Pull-ups are an exercise that will test your upper body strength. Having excellent upper body strength is ideal for handling a motorcycle. You will be thankful if you ride a large motorcycle with a powerful engine. More upper body strength will let you more easily control your motorcycle around tight corners and turns.

#### **Squats**

Along with upper body strength, you also need lower body strength to handle a motorcycle well. Simple squats can give you lower body strength. Squats will also help you work on your flexibility and balance. Having excellent balance is essential for a safe motorcycle ride. If you cannot keep yourself steady during turning, acceleration, or braking, you will be in big trouble on the road or the track. Eventually, you can work your way up to doing squats with weights.

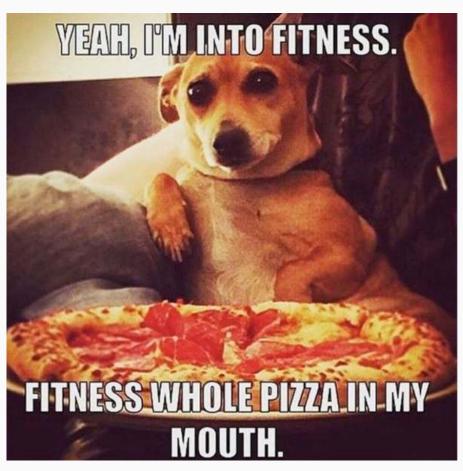
#### Lunges

Lunges are another exercise that works out your lower body and improves flexibility. Many different riding techniques depend on good lower body strength, particularly in your legs. For example, if you need to put a knee down on a race track while taking a corner. Lunges give you quads, glutes, and hamstrings a proper workout. You can also do them wherever and whenever.

#### **Bicycle Riding**

Although it may sound a little funny to ride a bicycle to get in shape to ride a motorcycle, it is a good test of your endurance and stamina. Cycling for a few miles will help you build yourself up for long drives on your motorcycle. Mountain biking is another similar exercise option. Mountain bikes require you to use and work out a lot of the same muscles you need for a regular motorcycle ride.

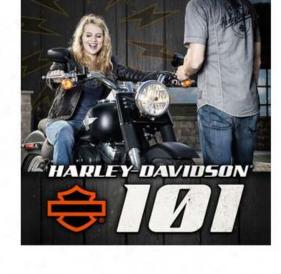
