

Steelhead Harley-Davidson Sizzlin' Saturdays

Arrive at 11:30 am to get set up and be ready to serve at **noon**.

Steelhead Staff should have the BBQ, Serving Table, & Water sitting out. If you need help finding anything, just ask Daryl, or at the front desk to get you started.

You will need to do the following:

- Turn on propane and fire up the grill...to light just turn the burners on high & hit the starter button; then adjust as needed
- Roll out 4-wheeled gray cart - for taking items out and using as outside storage. Daryl will have the cart ready to go when you get there
- Make sure you have tongs and sharp knife for opening hot dog packages
- Put hot dogs on grill (when it is hot outside grab a couple packs of dogs & leave extra dogs in the cooler until needed)
- Use metal pan with rack in the bottom for keeping cooked dogs warm, but not sitting in water (put water in the bottom, then wire rack, this works great for keeping the dogs warm)
- Place these items on the serving table:
 - Buns (keep in bag until ready to use)
 - Box of chips
 - Condiments – there are four cubed acrylic containers, put a layer of ice in bottom of two containers and fill top containers, one with relish & one with sauerkraut
 - Ketchup, mustard, hot dog trays, napkins, a few plastic knives & forks
 - Donation jar (hot dogs are free, but people may donate)
 - Sunset HOG fliers, with membership form attached
 - The donation jar, Sunset HOG fliers and receipt book are located in the cabinet under the Sunset Chapter Calendar. The Sunset HOG fliers plus membership forms are on top of the cabinet and are for people who would like more information about our Chapter
- Chapter Flag/Banner should be hung upon the beams behind the grill for all prospects to see
- Yes, you may bring items from home to supplement the bill of fare - chili, cheese, hamburgers and buns, fruit, potato salad, brownies

You may begin clean-up at 3:00pm. or when you run out of hot dogs

- **Clean grill & turn off propane** at tank – Steelhead staff will put away the grill, water cooler and table
- Use paper towels and Windex to **wipe down the serving table and side shelves of grill**
- Place any leftover cooked hot dogs on plates or in food boats and put them on the break room/kitchen table
- In the kitchen sink, wash the pan that is used to keep hot dogs warm, grate, tongs as well as any serving utensils and knife
- Put unused items back where you found them; relish and sauerkraut in the kitchen refrigerator, mustard and ketchup in the box
- **Both volunteers should count the money** then take the money to Tim, at the top of the stairs at Steelhead, to count the money and fill out a receipt for the amount. **Both volunteers should sign the receipt.** One volunteer takes a receipt to give to the Treasurer the next time you see her. If you are a Road Captain member, please indicate that on the receipt, so the funds go to that group.
